



## Spring Fundraising Guide

- **Have an Easter Bake Sale**
  - Sell plastic Easter eggs filled with candy and have prize slips in 3 of the eggs.
  - Have the eggs in a big Easter basket and sell them for 50 cents each.
  - Sell some baked goods alongside your eggs for extra cash.
  - Eggs that contain prize slips get to choose from:
    - A filled Easter Basket
    - A fluffy bunny
    - A large chocolate bunny
  
- **Easter Baskets**
  - Create large Easter Baskets, not just kids' baskets, but some that adults would like too.
  - Hold a raffle or silent auction for the baskets.
  
- **Breakfast with the Easter Bunny**
  - Set up a breakfast at a local restaurant, church or city building.
  - Have the Easter Bunny there for pictures with the kids.
  - Set up a Spring Picture area.
  - Charge \$5.00 per person for the breakfast and each child gets a free picture with their breakfast purchase.
  
- **Easter Egg Hunt**
  - Hold an Easter Egg Hunt for children in your community. You can hold it at a local church, city building or someone's farm.
  - Charge \$2.00 per child to hunt for the eggs.
  - Have the Easter Bunny there for photos for an extra donation to Relay.
  
- **Combine any of the above**
  - We're Relayers – we want the most for our time and effort!
  - Have the Easter Egg Hunt after your Breakfast with the Easter Bunny or have your Easter Basket Auction during the breakfast.
  
- **Hold a Garage Sale**
  - Don't underestimate garage sales!

- **Put Together an Outdoor Event**
  - People are anxious to get outside after being cooped up all winter.
  - Hold a 5K walk / run
  - Hold a softball tournament
  - Hold a golf tournament
  
- **Put Together Care Packages**
  - Have them available for parents to buy for their student's finals week.
  - Put things like Easter candy, dorm friendly snacks, stress release lotion.
  - Make it possible for parents to personalize with their kids favorite things.
  
- **Hold a Car Wash**
  - Everyone's anxious to get their cars clean after a long Winter of salt and grime build up.
  - Hold it on a Saturday in a busy location (restaurant parking lot, gas station, shopping mall, etc.).
  - Don't forget to get permission from a manager!
  
- **Spring Clean Team**
  - Advertise that you will Spring Clean people's homes for a donation to Relay.
  - Some people would love to have help cleaning their homes, and knowing the money goes to Relay is an even bigger benefit!
