Change For A Cure is a fundraising program for schools and school students to benefit the American Cancer Society Relay For Life in their fight to eliminate cancer as a health issue.

How Change For A Cure Works:

This fundraising and awareness raising program is designed to be simple. There is no selling and no paperwork involved. Participation is easy by:

- Designating one person as the school's Change For A Cure Coordinator
- Choose a day or week, but keep it to a specific and brief period of time for the event
- Ask teachers and students to ask their parents, neighbors or anyone they come in contact with for the "change in their pocket" to fight cancer
- On the designated day, each teacher and student brings the change they collected to school
- The school Change For A Cure Coordinator sends the change to Relay For Life

Fun and Rewarding:

Although competition between classes is not necessary, it is often fun and produces greater results! Competition between schools in a community is also fun and helps students feel they have made a significant contribution in their own community.

Simple rewards, such as a Pizza Party for the class who collects the most, can greatly help boost participation.
